Dominique J. E. Dreyer obtained his law degree at the University of Fribourg in 1974 and passed the Bar exam in Geneva in 1976. Having a strong affinity for the anglo-saxon culture, he decided to continue his studies in the USA and obtained the Master of Laws of the University UC of Berkeley (California) in 1977 ; in addition he participated in 2001 in the 'Executive Programme' of the Kennedy School of Government (Harvard).

Dominique J. E. Dreyer, co-founder of Hartmann Dreyer, advises mainly corporations in all questions of Corporate Law (regarding their structure and their functioning), Contract Law, in particular contracts of mandate, including those for services, as well as agency and distribution. He is also a renowned expert in Competition Law and Unfair Competition Law and published various works, amongst which his doctoral thesis « Puissance d'achat en droit suisse de la concurrence » in 1981.

Domnique J. E. Dreyer also served from 1985 to 1997 as deputy judge in the State Superior Court and was deputy chairman of the commission for the acquisition of real estate by foreigners.
